

# Adobe Photoshop CC: Cropping an Image

This tutorial is for new users of Photoshop CC who are still learning basic tasks and functions within the software.

## Introduction

Adobe Photoshop CC (Creative Cloud) can seem quite daunting to the new user. There are so many features a small task like cropping an image can seem intimidating.

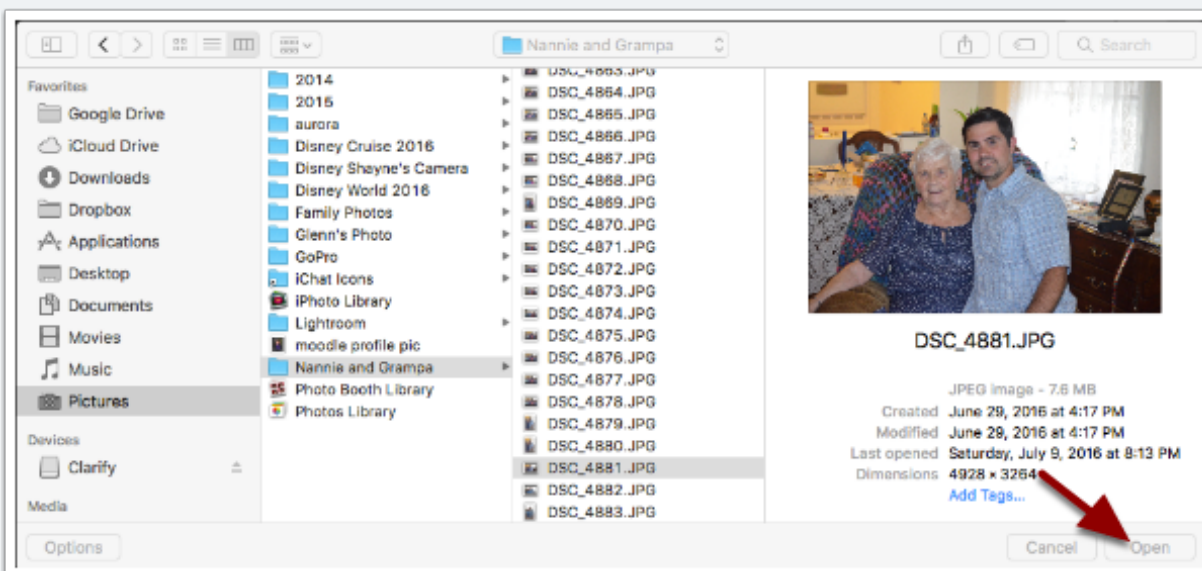
At the end of this tutorial, the student will be able to operate Adobe Photoshop CC in order to select an image of their choice and crop it.



# Adobe Photoshop CC: Cropping an Image

## Step 1: Select an Image to Crop

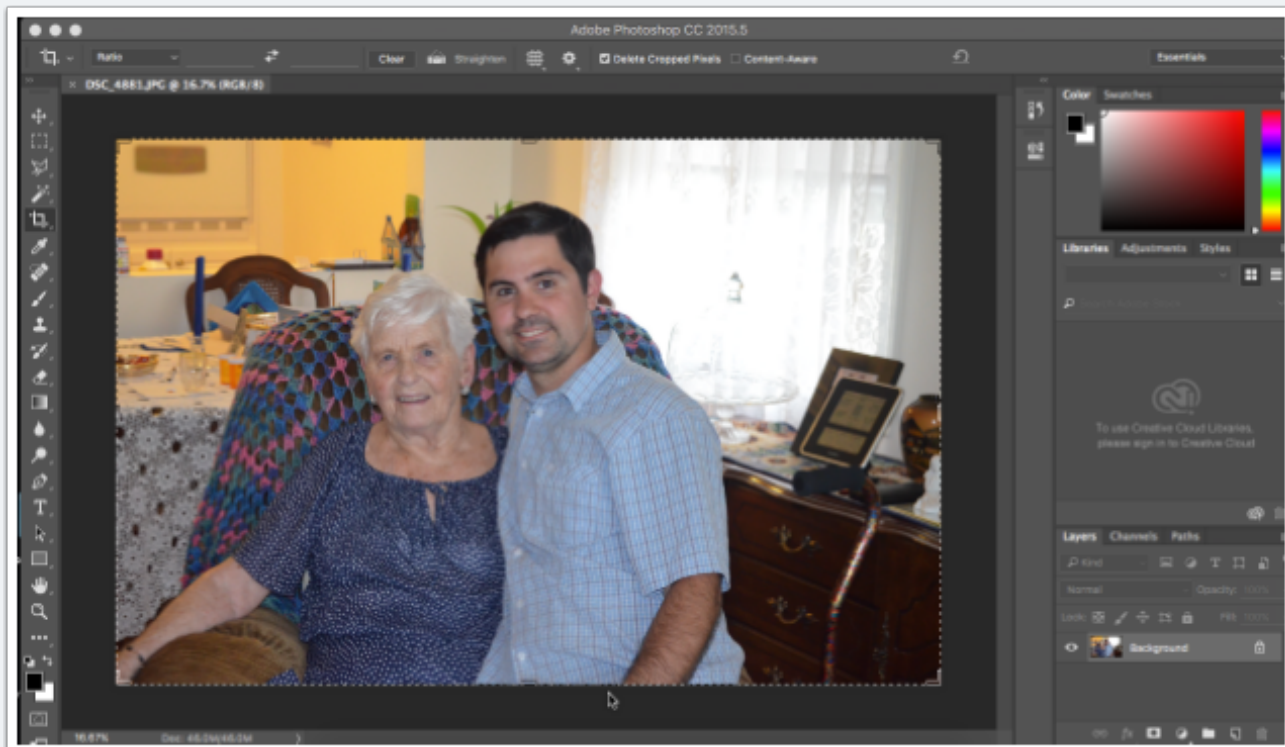
Once you have opened Adobe Photoshop CC, select the "File" menu, and Open. Browse to your desired image. Select "Open."



# Adobe Photoshop CC: Cropping an Image

## Step 2: Select the Crop Tool

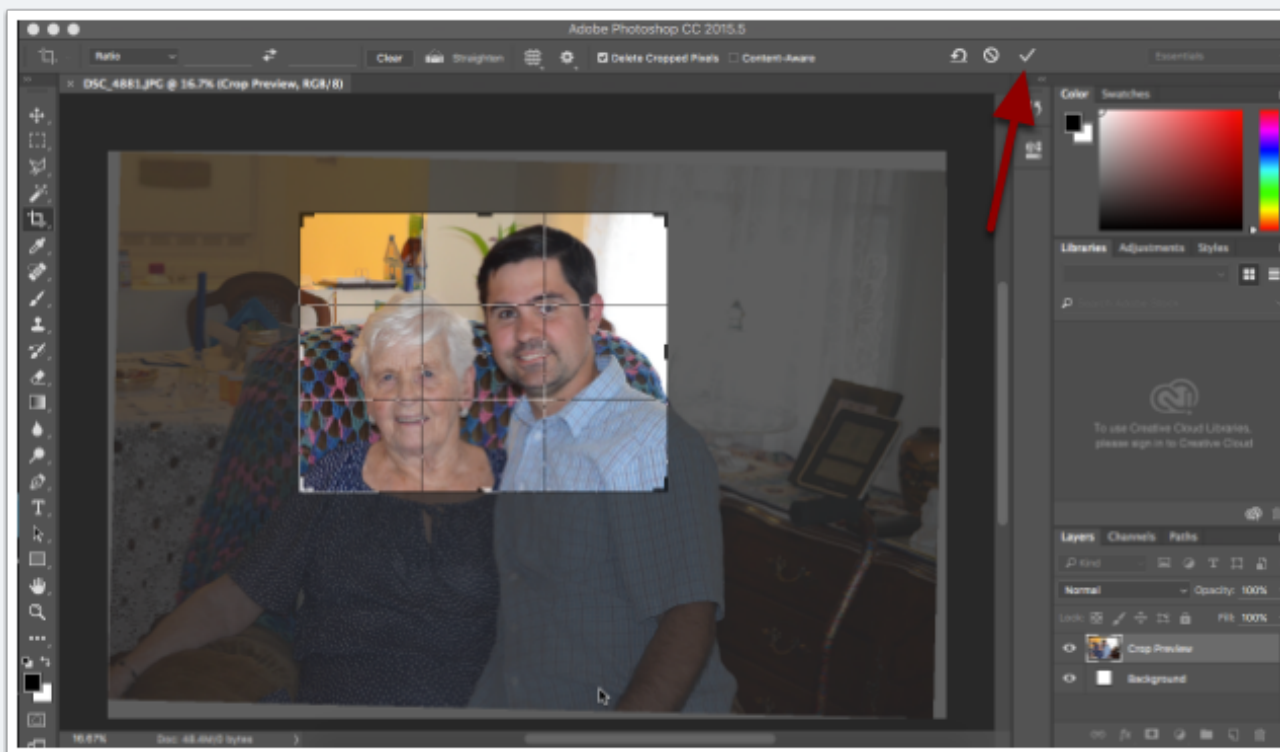
Select the Crop Tool in the toolbar. You will notice each corner of the image changes to show you are in cropping mode.



# Adobe Photoshop CC: Cropping an Image

## Step 3: Adjust and Crop

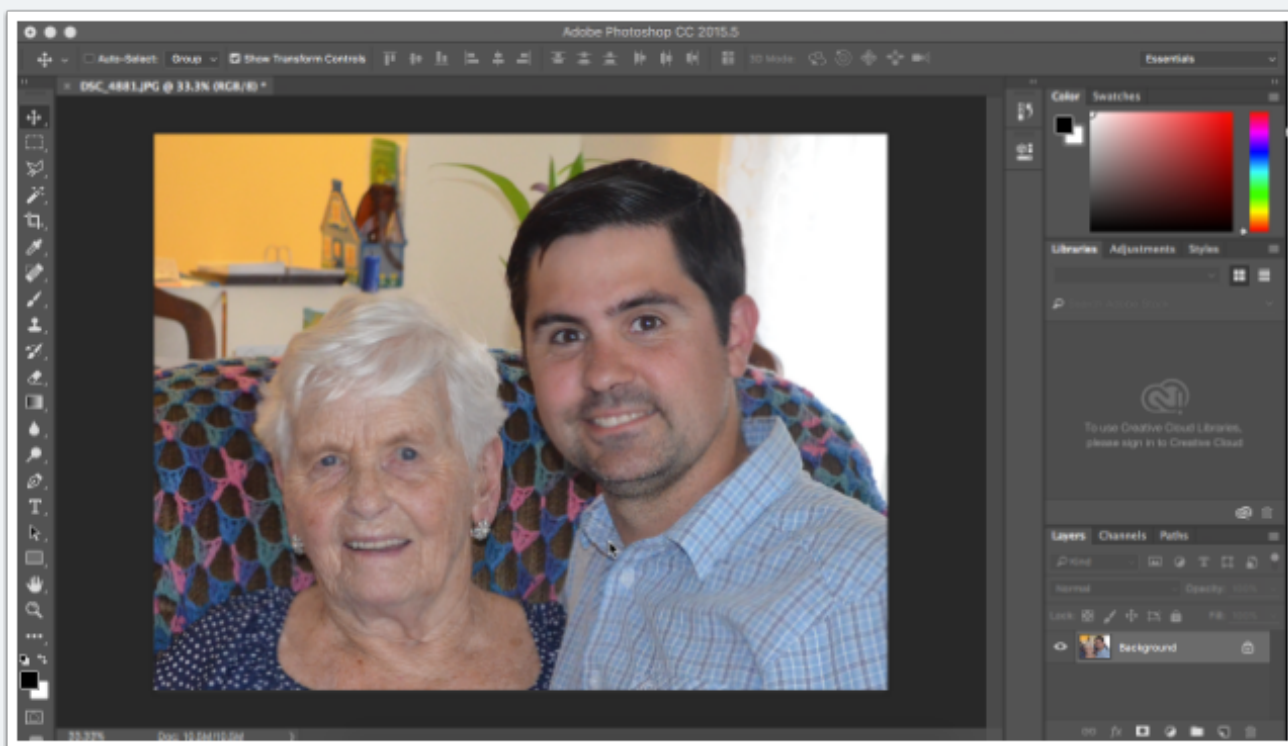
By selecting the corners, you can adjust the area of the image that you will want after you apply the crop. If you place your cursor in the dark area just outside the image, you can rotate as well. Once you are done, select the Checkmark to apply your crop.



# Adobe Photoshop CC: Cropping an Image

## Step 4: Determine if Crop is Complete

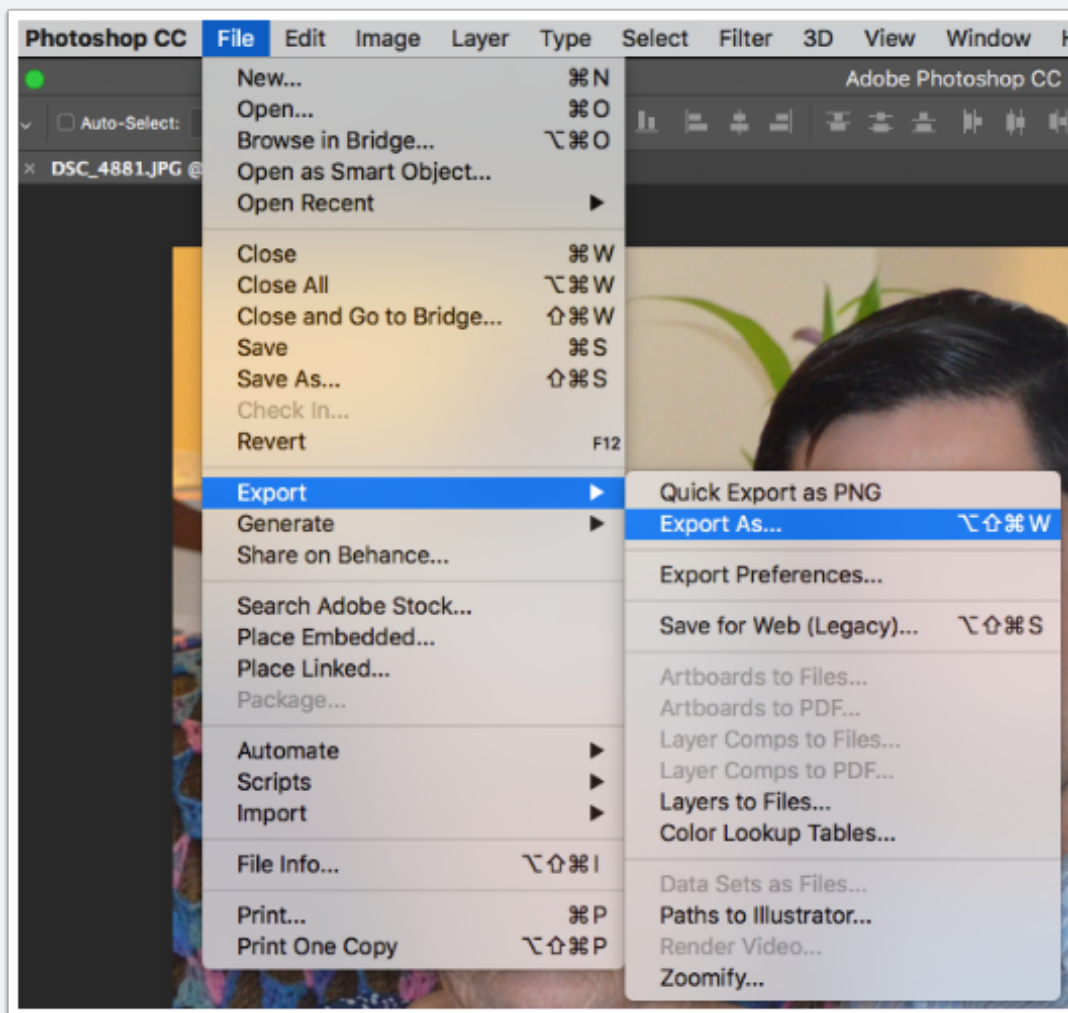
Take a look at your image. If you are happy with the crop, proceed to Step 5. If you are not happy with it, select the "Edit" Menu and "Step Backward" and go back to Step 3.



# Adobe Photoshop CC: Cropping an Image

## Step 5: Save or Export Image

Now that you are happy with your crop, you will want to save it. You have three options: you can save over the original image, save as another image, or export to another image format. Save and Save As work the same as most other applications. If you "Save" or "Save As" you are complete! If you want to export your image, proceed to Step 6.

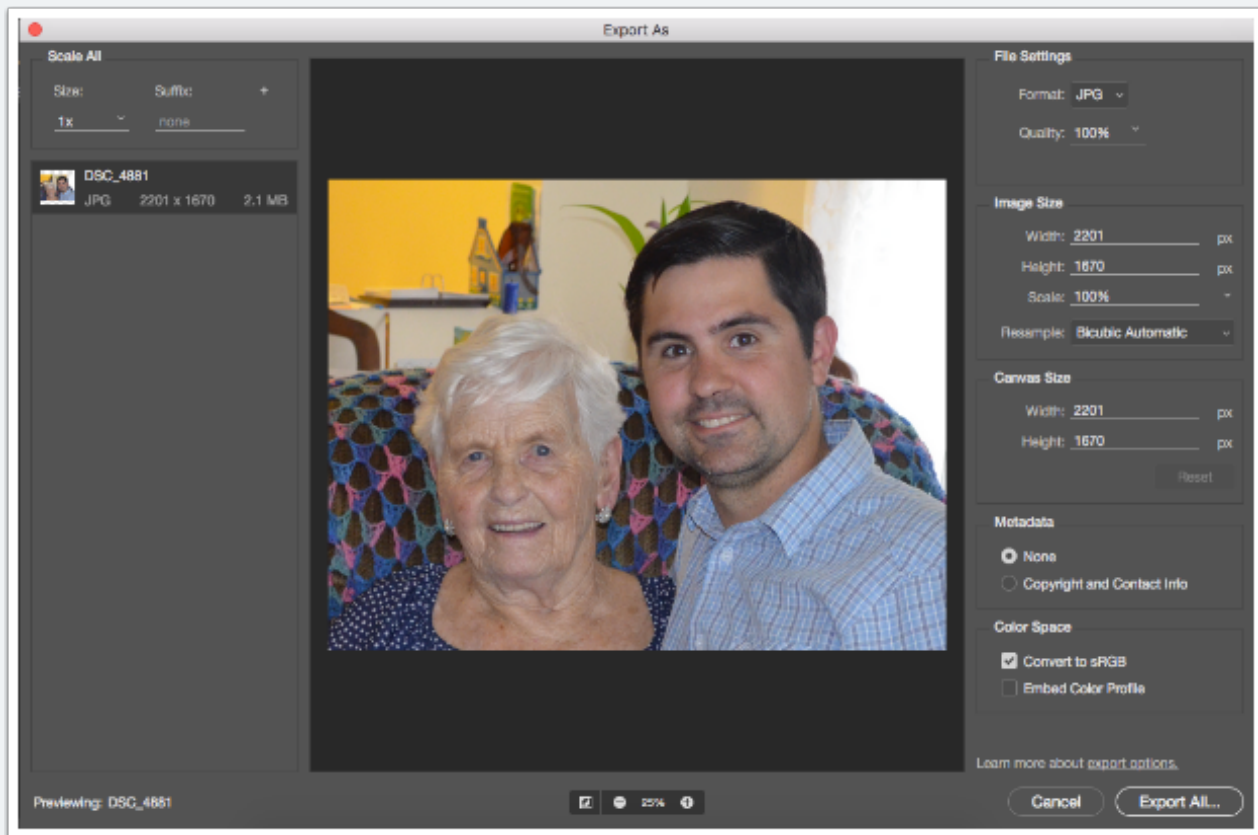




# Adobe Photoshop CC: Cropping an Image

## Step 6: Export As

In order to export, you select the "File" Menu, "Export" and "Export As." Select the options you desire based on your future use of the image in the "Export As" menu. If you have chosen to export your image, you are complete once this is done. Good job!
